PROGRAMS

Our exciting, engaging programs suit every student's ability, interests and goals!

ALBERTA CURRICULUM

Namao School follows the Alberta Curriculum, which specifies the knowledge and skills that students are expected to learn, set by Alberta Education.

HEADSTART

Headstart is designed for children between the ages of 3½ to 5 who need communication and/or developmental support. Children get a jumpstart on their education, building skills in communication, social development, physical development and emotional development. Screening is required.

ENRICHMENT

The Enrichment program is designed for preschool and kindergarten students who are deemed developmentally advanced. Enrichment focuses on academic enrichment and encourages community involvement, exposing children to music, art, books and second languages. Screening is required.

KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten students are packed with passion and potential to be anything they want in the world. We work hand-in-hand with parents, offering alternate full day programming to prepare each learner for the transition from home to school and entry into Grade 1.

KNOWLEDGE & EMPLOYABILITY (K&E)

This unique program is available for students in grades 8 and 9 who learn best through hands-on activities. Learning skills essential for the workplace, community and home, students obtain a sense of success and entry-level job skills.

ATHLETICS

We offer cross country running, a running club, volleyball, basketball, badminton and track and field. Students in grades 6 to 9 participate in interschool league play.



MUSIC

Namao School has an excellent, award-winning music program that includes an elementary choir and elementary and junior high school bands. Whether students are singing in choir, learning a new instrument or performing at festivals, our music program has something exciting for everyone!

PROGRAM UNIT FUNDING

PUF provides assistance for students between the ages of 2 ½ and 6 years who have a diagnosed need in one or more areas (speech and language, behavior and fine or gross motor skills). PUF children are fully included in preschools and kindergarten, as well as supported at home, to help your child reach his/her potential.
