On Tuesday June 10th, Grade 8 students will be participating in a field trip to the Edmonton Japanese Community Association. They will be taking part in a school program called “Japan Today”, designed as a supplement to the Japan module of the Grade 8 Social Studies curriculum.

The day will consist of a variety of hands-on activities such as origami, Japanese name writing, wearing yukata, and martial arts. Also, students will become more familiar with the Japanese language and customs, and are invited to order a Japanese meal to accompany their trip!

The cost of this trip is **\$25** and can be submitted via your student's PowerSchool profile, along with the permission form.

Students have the option of bringing their own lunches, or purchasing a Japanese lunch to be delivered to the Community Association.
